Regional Hospital District Board Meets

The Regional Hospital District Board gave approval to capital expenditures of \$420,000 for rewiring required for the Kelowna General Hospital. The rewiring is required to accommodate data transmissions and is part of an overall upgrade that has been previously included in the budget. The Regional Hospital District Board is made up of the same members of the Regional District Board and meets as required on decisions pertaining to the capital funding of the Regional Hospital District.

Curbside Recycling Bylaw Approved

The Regional Board gave final approval to the Bylaw that



regulates the collection of curbside recycling and depot operations. The new Curbside Recycling Program starts the first week of July. The service will be provided to those homes who currently receive garbage collection provided by their Regional or Municipal Government. This represents 41,000 homes in the Central Okanagan region, stretching from Lake Country to Peachland, including the Westside and City of Kelowna. There will also be four recycling depots available to provide continued service to residents and those living in apartments, Band Lands, or small businesses that are not part of the
