Highlights of the Regional Board Meeting– December 17, 2003

Official Referendum Results

The Regional Board has received a report from the Chief Election Officer on the Mount Boucherie Community Centre Expansion Referendum. The report confirms the official publicized results that saw a total of 5,759 ballots cast during two days of Advance Voting and the General Voting day, Saturday December 6th. There were 4,213 Yes votes and 1,546 No votes cast in the Referendum balloting.

Expansion Borrowing Bylaw Adopted

The Regional Board has adopted the borrowing bylaw for expansion of the Mount Boucherie Community Centre. Bylaw No. 1029 authorizes the Regional District to borrow up to \$3,288,631 to pay for the proposed addition to the Community Complex. The total cost of the expansion project is estimated at just over \$5.1 million.

Technical Review Of Expansion Plans

The Regional Board has approved a recommendation that will see a Technical Construction Committee formed to oversee expansion of the Mount Boucherie Community Centre. The Committee will consist of five Regional District staff members, Westside Director David Knowles, a member of the Westside Parks and Recreation Commission, Renaissance Architecture and Design Consultants and the manager of the Construction project. Once in place, the Committee will review the approved detailed concept plan and Value Analysis Review of the project. Any recommended changes will have to go before the Regional Board for approval.
